

As readers we will be developing our phonics skills working on set 2 and 3 sounds. We have just received a lot of lovely new books as well as our Super & so we will be reading all the time!

As geographers we will be thinking about coasts and linking this to our local area.

As mathematicians, we learn about mass and capacity, shapes and statistics. We will then concentrate on basic number skills.

As writers we will explore different texts and write letters, adventure stories and writing descriptions.

As musicians we will be studying 'The Dragon Song.' This is a little bit funky and music from around the world which links to story telling and using our imagination

As scientists we be investigating light for the first half term and habitats in the second half term.



In RE we will be thinking about what makes a good leader and a good teacher. We will link this to significant people and how we can do this ourselves.

As historians we will be learning about how travel and transport has changed over time— learning about how cars and aeroplanes have changed.

As design technologists we will be linking our ideas to science and designing and making a battery operated light,

As athletes we will be having cricket lessons every Tuesday before half term and (weather permitting) athletics outside after the half term. We will also host a sports day in June.

As digital creators we will learn to recognise that different devices can be used to capture photographs and will gain experience capturing, editing, and improving photos. Finally, we will use this knowledge to recognise that images they see may not be real.

As artists we will create sculptures using natural resources found in our local area. .
